This workforce handles diverse and demanding tasks, from carrying heavy loads to working with hazardous materials such as deadly crystalline silica dust.

A Safe and Clean Work Environment

At LATICRETE, the health and safety of our workers is of utmost importance, including the components within our products that are used by installers on a daily basis. In addition to enhancing project performance, we also evaluate how our building solutions impact the health and safety of our workers. An important aspect of this effort is to create products with zero or low levels of respirable crystalline silica, which is a common hazard in many job sites and can have long-term health consequences when inhaled regularly.

Another crucial aspect of our sustainability efforts is reducing volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in our products. VOCs are commonly found in many construction materials, including adhesives, coatings, and sealers. VOCs can contribute to the formation of ground-level ozone and smog, posing risks to workers and inhabitants of buildings. Today, a major percentage of our product range is certified as low VOC, minimising the added risk to workers and building occupants.

Our commitment to safety is evident in our new large-format installation range, which includes 257 TITANIUM™ and 335 LITE, premium adhesives that are lightweight and completely sand free, offering almost half the weight of traditional bags with the same coverage.

Lightweight & Sand-Free Products

LATICRETE has developed lightweight products that retain the same properties and functions as our original formulas but at almost half the weight. These solutions are in high demand because they are safer for workers and reduce strain on tile installation systems. Our low-weight solutions do not compromise the performance of our trusted installation materials. Not only do these lightweight products benefit the installer, we're seeing improved effectiveness at the worksite, as installation times can be significantly reduced when the workforce has a lighter burden to carry. These products have been manufactured to be sand-free, presenting no risk of respirable crystalline silica exposure.

Three Steps Forward

As LATICRETE looks towards a green future, we turn our attention toward three key initiatives that reflect our commitment to sustainability and guide our actions towards a more eco-friendly industry.

Manufacturing

LATICRETE sustainability efforts begin right at the start of our production line. By starting with recyclable raw materials, we minimise our use of natural resources. Our Brisbane manufacturing plant and office has also implemented solar panels to reduce our energy footprint. On top of that, we have been phasing out harmful solvents in our products in order to replace them with water-based alternatives.

Product Design

Our entire product range is being designed with the environment and safety in mind, presenting innovative new solutions, from phasing out harmful solvents to replace them with water-based alternatives, to the SUPERCAP pump truck, a large volume flooring installation system which uses recycled material with less exposure to dust and less heavy lifiting.

Lasting Installations

One of the most significant ways we maintain our committment to sustainability is by enabling lasting installations that stand the test of time. With our lifetime warranties, we ensure that our products will not break down or fail, saving costs to the environment and workers that would be caused be replacing installations. And by investing so much in training, we ensure our users are installing LATICRETE products correctly for their own safety, and to ensure these installations are lasting.
