5. INSTALLATION

Read entire label before using. Use only as directed. Be sure surfaces to be cleaned are swept or vacuumed to remove loose debris. Avoid skin and eye contact with product. Wear protective eyewear and gloves when handling. Keep children and pets out of the area during application and drying.

- 1. Prior to using, test on a discrete area or scrap piece of tile to insure desired results.
- 2. Shake well before use.
- 3. Use pure or diluted with water:

- 4. Apply mixed solution with a damp mop, sponge or appropriate professional cleaning equipment.
- 5. Clean entire area, changing cleaning solution often to ensure that soil is not redeposited. Always rinse and clean with water.
- 6. Let area dry completely before using.
