## 5. INSTALLATION

Read entire label before using. Use only as directed. Be sure surfaces to be cleaned are swept or vacuumed to remove loose debris. Avoid skin and eye contact with product. Wear protective eyewear and gloves when handling. Ensure work area is well-ventilated during application and until surface is dry. Keep children and pets out of the area during application and drying.

- 1. Prior to using, test on a discrete area or scrap piece of tile to insure desired results.
- 2. Shake well before use.
- 3. Use pure or diluted with water:

- 4. Apply mixed solution with a mop, clean cloth, brush, or appropriate professional cleaning equipment (i.e. medium-hard single disc floor cleaner).
- Lightly rub with a scrub brush or floor machine as needed.
- 6. Remove STONETECH® KLENZALLL™ CLEANER residues using a clean cloth, wet/dry vacuum, or damp mop.
- 7. Rinse area well with clean water.
- 8. Let area dry completely before using. Reseal cleaned area with a STONETECH sealer.
