3. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

STONETECH® RESTORE™ ACIDIC CLEANER is a heavy duty, acidic cleaner that removes dirt, hard water deposits, efflorescence and rust from tile and acid resistant stone, masonry and grout. It quickly renews the surface to a like-new appearance. This water-based cleaner does not fume during use, can be diluted to light, medium and heavy duty use, and also cleans tough soap scum and light grout haze.

Limitations

- Conduct a test area on polished marble and acid sensitive stones (i.e. slate) to determine suitability and acceptability.

5. INSTALLATION

Read entire label before using. Use only as directed. Always test in a small inconspicuous area to determine required dilution and results. Be sure surfaces to be cleaned are swept or vacuumed to remove loose debris. This acid-based cleaner will etch or damage most polished marble, limestone and travertine surfaces. Will etch or corrode most metal surfaces. Avoid skin and eye contact. Do not breathe vapours. Ensure work area is well-ventilated during application and until surface is dry. Keep children and pets out of the area during application and drying.

Directions

- 1. Shake well before use.
- 2. Dilute concentrated cleaner with warm water according to the following mixing chart, depending on surface to be cleaned and dirt to be removed:

Use	STONETECH® RESTORE™ ACIDC CLEANER	Water	Ratio
Frequent Cleaning	50 ml	1 L	5% (5:100)
Deep Cleaning	200 - 500 ml	1L	20 - 50% (2:10 or 5:10)

- 3. Prior to using, test on a discrete area or scrap piece of tile to insure desired results.
- 4. Mask off and protect any metals or other surfaces not intended to be treated. Apply mixed solution with a clean mop or towel.
- Agitate with a scrub brush, abrasive pad, or floor machine as needed.
- 6. Remove STONETECH RESTORE™ ACIDIC CLEANER using a clean cloth, wet/dry vacuum or damp mop.
- Rinse area well with clean water and wipe dry using a clean cloth.
- 8. Thoroughly rinse all metal surfaces with clean water. Clean and rinse equipment with water.
- 9. Repeat washing if necessary (i.e. to remove any remaining stains or "effervescence").
- 10. Reseal cleaned area with a STONETECH sealer (i.e. STONETECH BULLETPROOF® SEALER)

Tile and stone routine cleaning with a neutral pH cleaner such as STONETECH® STONE & TILE CLEANER is recommended. For tough or difficult to remove soil use STONETECH® KLENZALL™ CLEANER, a nylon scrubbing pad or a long handled stiff bristle brush.
