3. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

5. INSTALLATION

Read entire label before using. Use only as directed. Always test in a small inconspicuous area before application to determine ease of application and desired results. Be sure all surfaces to be cleaned are swept or vacuumed to remove loose debris. Ensure work area is well-ventilated during application and until surface is dry. Keep children and pets out of the area until surface use resumes. Avoid contact with surfaces not intended to be treated.

Directions

- 1. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Do not dilute before applying.
- 2. Liberally apply an even coat of STONETECH® EPOXY GROUT HAZE & COATING STRIPPER over the area with a paint brush, mop or paint pad. On vertical surfaces, apply from bottom to top. Immediately remove product from unintended surfaces with a wet cloth to prevent potential damage to those surfaces.
- 3. Let STONETECH® STONETECH® EPOXY GROUT HAZE & COATING STRIPPER penetrate for 5-10 minutes.
- 4. Do not let product dry on the surface. If it starts to dry, add more to keep surface wet.
- 5. After 5-10 minutes, agitate surface with a nylon scrub brush or abrasive pad after testing a small area first to make sure that brush or pad will not scratch stone.
- 6. Wipe up residue with clean, dry cloth or wet mop. A wet/dry vacuum can be used for larger area.
- 7. Rinse surface well with clean water.

8. More than one application may be required, repeat steps 1 through 7 when necessary.

Note: Do not exceed 15 minutes during each application as it may damage surface. Repeated short applications are recommended.
