**Limitations:** Mastic can be applied on damp surface but not on wet surfaces. For any rising moisture suitable moisture barrier primer like Guard Prime EPM is recommended. Drying time gets extended for damp surface, cold climate and humid conditions.

## **INSTALLATION**

# **Surface Preparation**

The concrete substrate must 28 days old and have compressive strength (minimum 25 N/mm2) with a minimum pull off strength of 1.5 N/mm2. Ensure the substrate is clean, dry and free of all contaminants such as dirt, oil, grease, coatings and surface treatments, etc. Concrete substrates must be prepared mechanically or by scarifying equipment to remove cement laitance and achieve an open textured surface.

Weak concrete must be removed and surface defects such as blow holes and voids must be fully exposed.

Remove all dust, loose and friable material from surfaces preferably by brush or vacuum before application of the product.

#### Mixing

Mastic is supplied in pre weighed kit consisting of Mix Part A and Part B.

For complete mixing, decant part A in a suitable container and mix with a low-speed drill and paddle, add part B, and mix for 2-3 minutes to a homogenous color mix.

For small repair work or spot repairs, take equal parts of Part A and Part B and mix with a scrapper or putty knife to a homogeneous color mix.

Apply mixed putty within its pot life depending upon site conditions.

## **Application**

**As a surface repair:** Apply with a suitable flat trowel or putty knife. Work on the pinholes and dents to cover the defects. Where a very deep recess is to be filled, it may be necessary to build up in layers.

For vertical surfaces, Mastic can be applied up to 5 mm thickness without sag.

**For crack repairs** < 5 mm, widen the crack into a v notch shape and fill with Mastic with a putty knife or trowel. Smooth surface can be achieved by grinding or sanding with a sandpaper after hard dry. Apply subsequent primer or Epoxy or PU floor levelling or coatings after 16 hours depending upon site conditions.

**As a tile bedding:** Apply a scratch coat on back side of tile. Apply with a suitable notch trowel at a thickness of 3 mm on the prepared substrate. Fix tile within the pot life of mastic. **Cleaning:** Clean tools and mixer with suitable cleaning solvent.
