# **Description:**

This presentation will discuss the most common potential problems associated with natural stone. We will define how to identify what the most common problems are, the cause of the issue and the typical method to minimize or prevent a problem. We will also discuss the most important characteristics of natural stone such as absorption, abrasion and hardness ratings and chemical sensitivity. We explore the way these stones are created and what minerals make up the stone, as well as look at the best practices for ongoing care and maintenance of natural stone.

- 1. Identify most common issues related to stone installations.
- 2. Identify the type of "green" chemistry available for stone repairs and prevention.
- 3. Understand the importance of Low VOC stone sealers and cleaners.
